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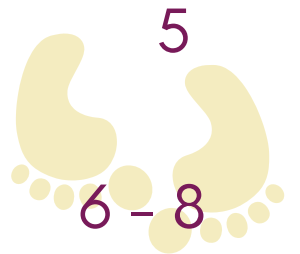
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Welcome to the neonatal unit

This booklet is to help you understand all the things we do to help your baby and how you can help too.

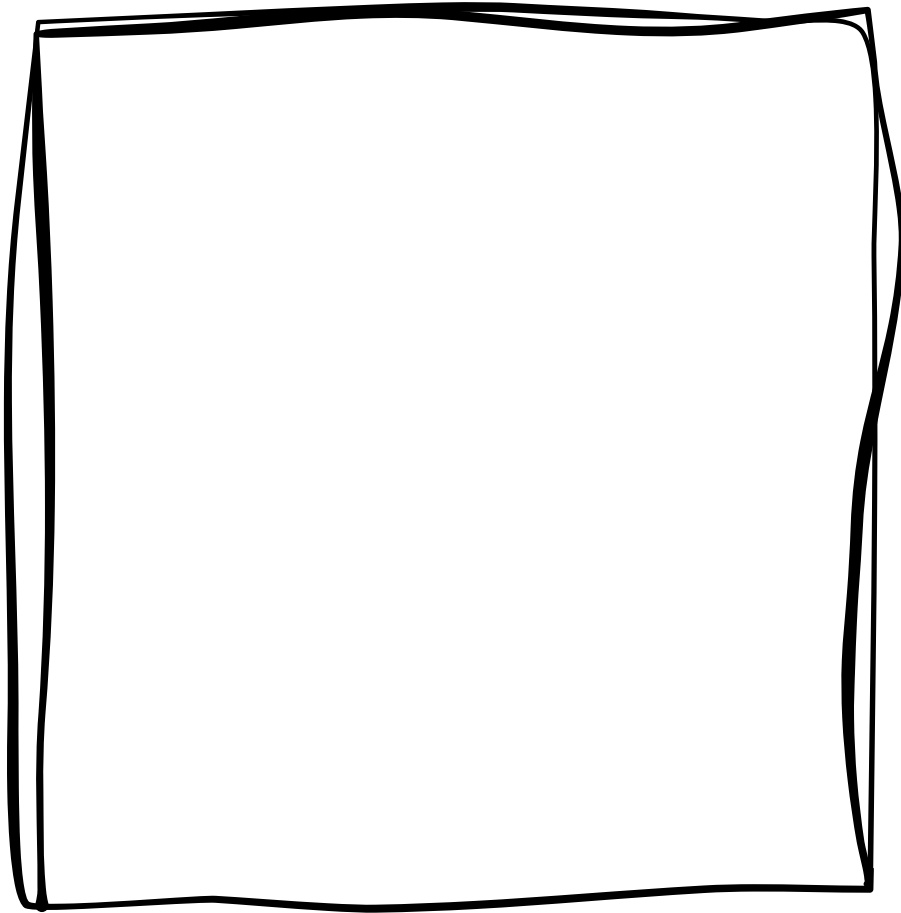
In this booklet there are activities, information and spaces for special memories so that all the family can remember your baby's time on the neonatal unit.

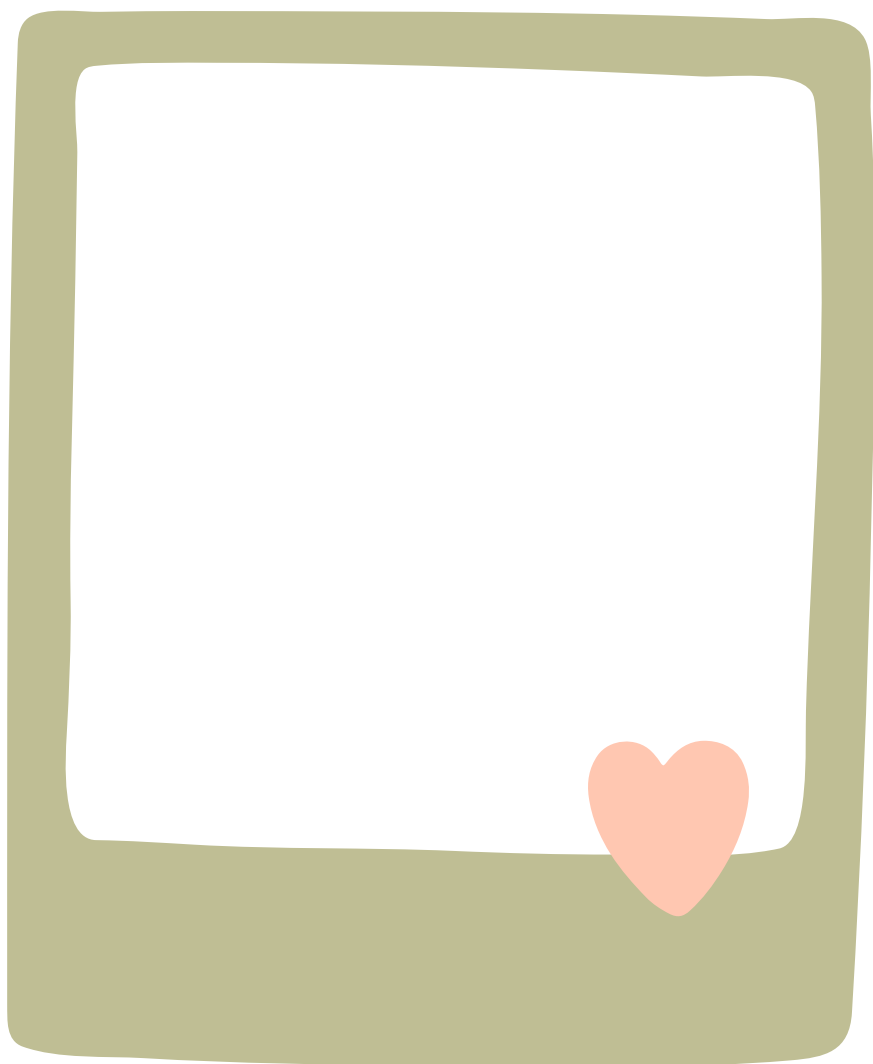

Keeps your baby warm and safe



Monitors

Help to look after your baby. They can sometimes be noisy

Ventilator/CPAP

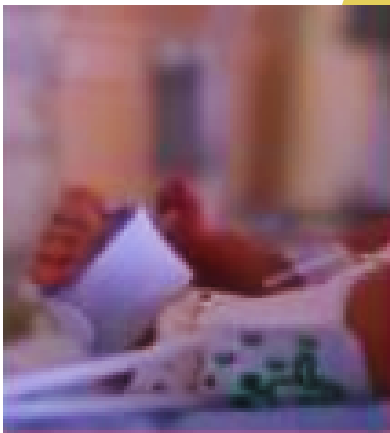
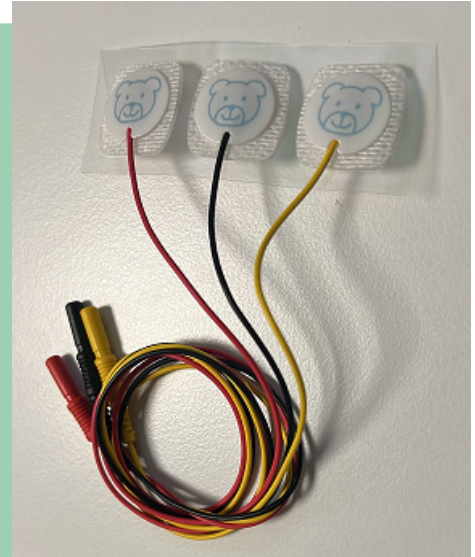
Helps your baby to breathe



Things our baby might need

ECG lead

This counts your baby's heart beat



Saturation Probe

This wraps around your baby's hand or foot to check that they are okay

Apnoea monitor

A sticker on your baby's tummy to check they are okay



Things our baby might need

NG Tube

This is goes up your baby's nose into their tummy to feed your baby milk and give them medicines



Incubator cover
is used to help your baby
feel comfortable

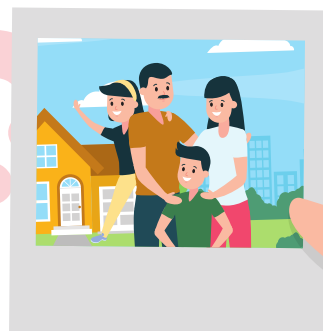
Lights

It is kept darker on the unit

Write them a letter

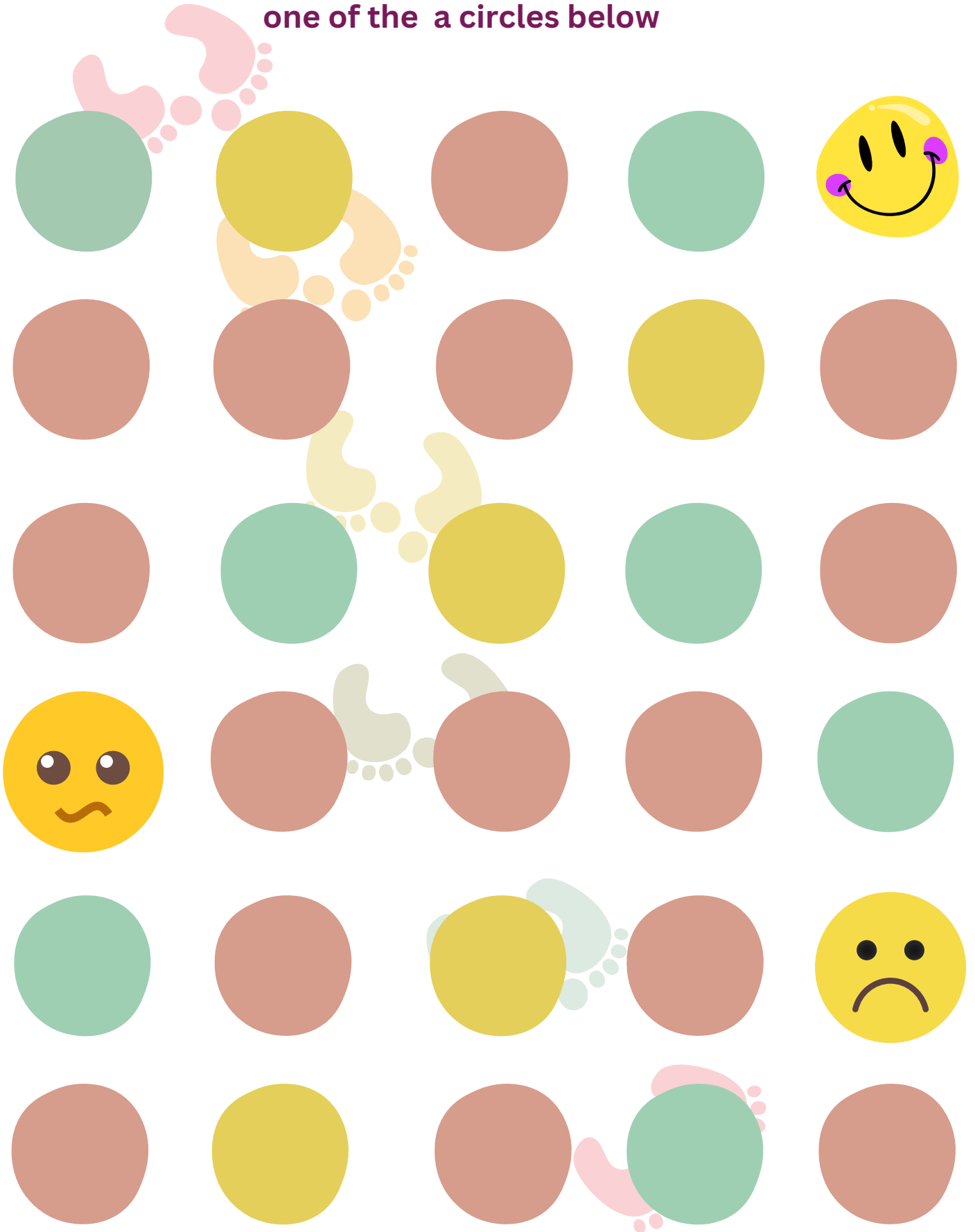

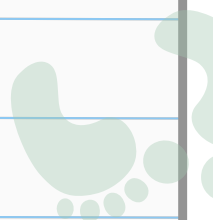
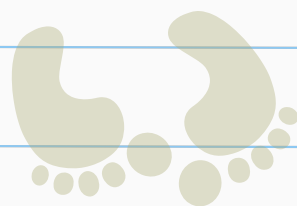
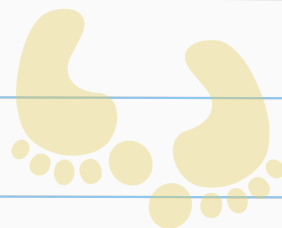
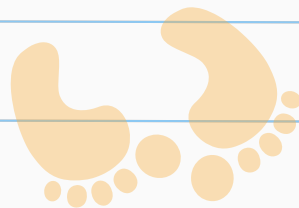
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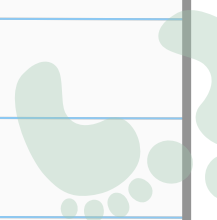
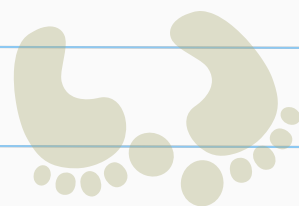
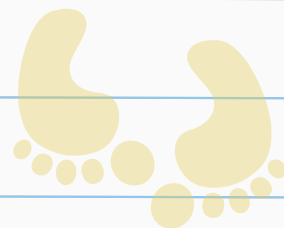
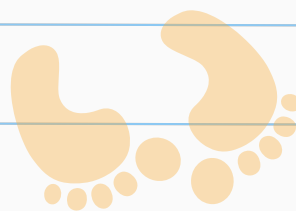
Our baby's diary
